Student-Athletes and Parents,

As communicated in May, 2010, the NCAA Eligibility Center, beginning this school year, will no longer accept any Integrated Math/Pre-College Math courses on their list of approved NCAA Core courses. However, all Integrated Math/Pre-College Math courses taken prior to the 2010-2011 school-year **will** be allowed by the NCAA. Therefore, in order to stay in compliance for qualification to an NCAA Division I or II athletic program, student-athletes currently in the integrated sequence have been informed of this change and have been given the option to transfer from the integrated course sequence to a traditional math course. Traditional math courses are those such as Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II.

Building principals, athletic directors and guidance counselors have worked very hard to ensure every student-athlete is placed in the appropriate courses, and will receive the necessary academic intervention for optimum success in the classroom. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact your child's guidance counselor.

Please understand that required and approved core courses are determined by the NCAA Eligibility Center for all high schools nationally, and this change is not a requirement of the Westerville City School district. All Integrated Math courses, both now and in the future, still count fully toward the graduation requirements set forth by the Westerville City Schools Board of Education. However, to ensure that all of our aspiring student-athletes are in compliance with NCAA regulations, we will follow the curricular guidelines as set forth by the NCAA Eligibility Center.
