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FOOD SERVICE ANNOUCEMENT REGARDING AN INCREASE IN SCHOOL LUNCH PRICING FOR 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

Per the USDA Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, and the Equity in School Lunch Pricing, effective July 1, 2011, school districts are required to charge paid status students who participate in the school lunch program at least equal to the difference in the reimbursement rates for free as compared to paid, so one group is not subsidizing the other.

Therefore, Westerville City Schools, will be requesting an increase in school lunch pricing, effective with the 2017-2018 school year, pending Board Approval on August 7, 2017, to meet the State mandates. Lunch prices this year will be:

Elementary	\$2.75 (increase of \$0.15)
Middle	\$3.00 (increase of \$0.15)
High	\$3.00 (increase of \$0.15)
Reduced Price Lunches:	\$0.40
Milk:	\$0.60

Breakfast prices remain the same for the 2017-2018 school year.

Elementary	\$1.25
Middle	\$1.50
High	\$1.50
Reduced Breakfast:	No charge
Milk:	\$0.60
