

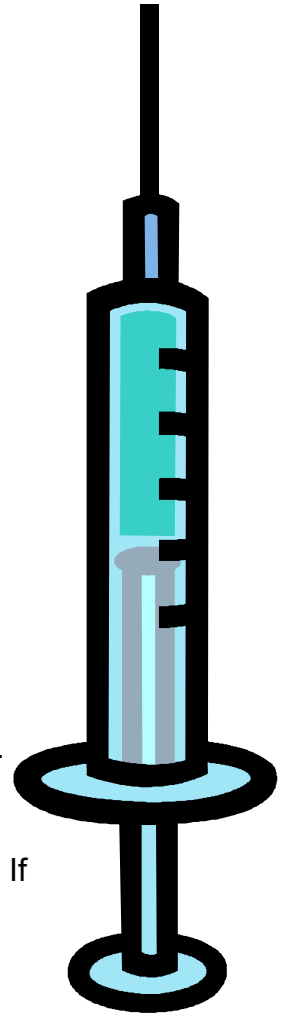
IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The **State of Ohio** requires children to be immunized if they are enrolled in public or private school for kindergarten,

Please Submit Shot Records at Registration

KINDERGARTNERS NEED:

1. **HEP B** (Hepatitis B)
3 doses required – may take 6 months to complete
2. **MMR** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
2 doses required, the first dose given on or after the first birthday.
3. **DTaP/DT Tdap/Td** (Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus)
5 doses required, unless the 4th dose was administered on or after the fourth birthday.
4. **IPV** (Polio)
3 or more doses required: last dose to be given on or after 4th birthday.
5. **VARICELLA** (Chickenpox) or disease history
2 doses required, the 1st dose being given on or after the first birthday. If the student has had the disease, verification/date may be provided by physician or parent.

APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED

¹The Columbus Health Department charges a \$21.00 administration fee per injection plus a \$16.00 nurse assessment fee per visit.

²The Franklin County Board of Health charges a \$28.00 administrative fee for the first injection and \$15.00 for each additional injection.

³Delaware County Board of Health charges \$19.00 for the first injection and \$10.00 for each additional injection.

Discounts may be available. No child is denied services due to inability to pay.

All adults are charged for vaccines.
Mother, Father, or Guardian must be present.
Check website for insurances accepted. You must present card at time of service.
You must bring a current shot record for service and a photo ID.
