

Morning School Delay

Morning SACC will not operate when school is delayed early in the morning, prior to the students' arrival, and public announcement has been made as to the delay of school.

Afternoon SACC will operate as scheduled when school begins after a morning delay.

Unscheduled, Early Release

SACC will not operate when school is dismissed early due to emergency conditions (severe weather conditions, public disaster, or a problem that renders a building unsafe for occupancy such as gas leak, no heat, broken water line, loss of electricity, etc.). The school will dismiss children from school according to the information parents/guardians have provided the school office on the Emergency Card. SACC may not be listed on the Emergency Card as an emergency release contact.

Snow Day or Other Emergency Conditions

SACC will not operate when school is closed due to emergency conditions (severe weather conditions, public disaster, or a problem that renders a building unsafe for occupancy such as gas leak, no heat, broken water line, loss of electricity, etc.).

Magnet School Students and Individual School Closings

If an individual school housing a SACC Program is closed due to specific emergency conditions pertaining to that school, the following procedure is in place for Magnet School Students:

SACC will not operate before school. Parents of Magnet School Students will be notified of the closure by YWCA Staff. Parents are responsible for morning care and transportation arrangements of Magnet School Students.

SACC will not operate after school. Parents of Magnet School Students will be notified of the closure by YWCA Staff. Parents are responsible for after school care and transportation arrangements of Magnet School Students.

Level Three Emergency

SACC will not operate under Level Three Emergency conditions.
