In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), Westerville City Schools is providing written annual Notification of the availability of our Asbestos Management Plan.

Per Federal regulations, Westerville City Schools had all buildings inspected for asbestos-containing materials and developed a Management Plan in December of 1988. This plan is updated every 6 months and is available for your review. 3. Various dates – Asbestos repair or removal as needed.
4. Review and update of Asbestos Management Plan.
5. Issuance of Annual Asbestos Management Plan Notification.
