I would like to take a moment to remind families to watch your email today for details about meal delivery for children 18 years of age and younger in specific portions of our district, as identified per USDA regulations. If you reside in one of these identified areas, our goal is to have this information to you by 4 p.m. today. However, given the logistics involved, it may be slightly later. Please begin watching your email at 4 p.m. for this important information.

I would also like to thank you in advance for your cooperation today as students and families visit our schools to retrieve their medications and personal belongings. Don't forget that, in addition to the specific building times shared in prior emails, all schools will be open today from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. to collect students' personal belongings and printed lesson materials, if necessary. These are unusual times for everyone, but as we are witnessing, by working together and following established instructions, we will get through this public health crisis as best as possible.

Finally, I want to let our families know that, should this closure be extended beyond April 5, we will have systems in place to address the new set of challenges that will be created as a result. Our offices will be closed at the end of the day today and employees will begin working from home, but please know that we are committed to supporting our students and families during this time.
