We have been able to acquire and activate approximately 100 mobile hotspots, which we are making available on a first-come, first-served basis to families that need access to the Internet. Hotspots will be available through the end of this week (April 17) for curbside pickup at the same times and locations as our Chromebook distribution:

- 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Huber Ridge Elementary (5757 Buenos Aires Blvd.)
- 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Robert Frost Elementary (270 N. Spring Rd.)

Once again, these devices are intended for families that do not have home Internet access. Also, there will not be a cost to families for the use of these devices. Thanks to a donation from Neighborhood Bridges, the district is able to cover these monthly costs until the end of the school year, at which time the service will be turned off.

Thank you for your continued patience, support and understanding as we continue our efforts to meet students' technology needs during these unprecedented times.
