**Before you participate in any college programming, you must complete the College Credit Plus registration process with the college/university you want to attend.** Be sure to complete each step below to participate in CCP programming during the 21-22 school year.

Apply to the College/University you want to attend and pay attention to deadlines. **Be sure to use your personal email address when applying.**

### Autumn Semester Deadlines for college partners:

- **CSCC: August, 2021** (*it is recommended that students apply well before this deadline as courses fill up quickly and it may be difficult to register for courses in late August*)
- **Otterbein University: May 15, 2021**
- **The Ohio State University: May 1, 2021**
- **University of Toledo: May 1, 2021**

Submit placement scores.

- Follow the college/university process for submitting placement scores.
- Note that Otterbein University and The Ohio State University are test-optional for the 2021-2022 school year.

- You will receive important information, including details on how to register for courses, from your academic advisor through your college email account. Consider forwarding this account to an email you check regularly.
