

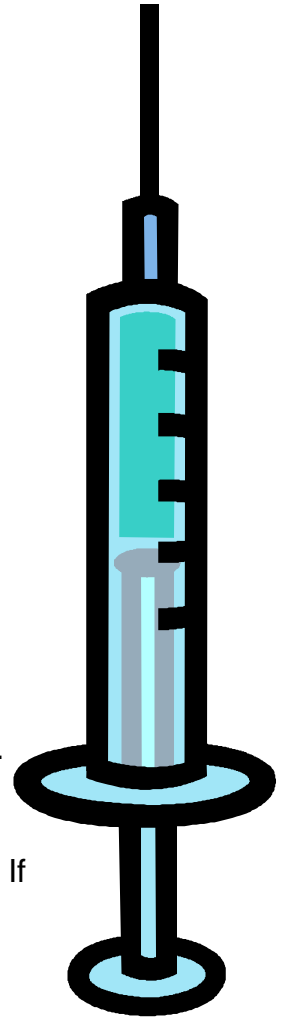
# IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The **State of Ohio** requires children to be immunized if they are enrolled in public or private school for kindergarten,

**Please Submit Shot Records at Registration**

## KINDERGARTNERS NEED:

1. **HEP B** (Hepatitis B)  
**3 doses required** – may take 6 months to complete
2. **MMR** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)  
**2 doses required**, the first dose given on or after the first birthday.
3. **DTaP/DT Tdap/Td** (Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus)  
**5 doses required**, unless the 4<sup>th</sup> dose was administered on or after the fourth birthday.
4. **IPV** (Polio)  
**3 or more doses required**: last dose to be given on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
5. **VARICELLA** (Chickenpox) or disease history  
**2 doses required**, the 1<sup>st</sup> dose being given on or after the first birthday. If the student has had the disease, verification/date may be provided by physician or parent.
